1) John confirms that the issue with PSM has been resolved and that RC2 is installing without issue on SLES 11 SP3

OFED status

- 1) OFED 3.5-2 RC2 released: http://www.openfabrics.org/downloads/OFED/ofed-3.5-2/OFED-3.5-2-rc2.tgz
 - a) dapl-2.0.39 support for heterogeneous PPB and i386 endian issues
 - b) infinipath-psm-3.1-4 support for SLES 11 SP3
 - c) libcxgb4-1.3.1

OFED 3.5-2 issues

- 1) The ibutils package is two years old and Mellanox has a new ibutils 2 package but at this point it is proprietary and they do not want to include it in OFED. We should add a note indicating a known limitation in the ibutils package that it does not support FDR, FDR 10 or EDR speeds when using ibdiagnet.
- 2) We should try and find a volunteer to update open source Woody will ask around and check with Todd Rimmer and Ira Weiny

OFED 3.12

- 1) New compat and compat-rdma
- 2) New packages-ofed-3.5

Questions

- 1) **John Jolly** when do you expect OFED 3.12 to be released?
 - a) Rupert: we were hoping for a daily build for the OFA Interop Debug Event which starts this week. I think it will be unlikely to have a GA before the end of the year
- 2) **Woody**: Since compat is updated, people need to start backports.

DAPL issues

- 1) Arlin can't resolve iWARP DAPL test issues because he does not have access to iWARP hardware.
- 2) Bug <u>2439</u> has general fixes and resolves endian issues with PPC and i86. It was verified to be fixed during the OFA Interop Debug event
- 3) Still open DAPL
 - a) 2441 needs to be addressed Woody asked Tatyana to look into this since it is iWARP

- b) Tatyana has sent some adapters to Sean Hefty and asks Woody to do some testing.
- c) Rupert will also ask UNH-IOL to review the iWARP bugs during the Interop event
- 4) Woody review of historical EWG bug process
 - a) The group scrub bugs and identifies priority 1 and critical bugs. These are addressed and the EWG will hold the release until they have been fixed.
 - b) Generally the older bugs with low priority get pushed out. They haven't always fixed everything and instead generally move the bugs to a lower priority or fix them
 - c) 2441 and 2445 (low priority but marked critical)
- 5) When should we move OFED 3.5-2 to GA
 - a) When we get to later stages, we test and if there are critical bugs we fix them.
 - b) Decide in two weeks whether the ones that are open should hold up release.
